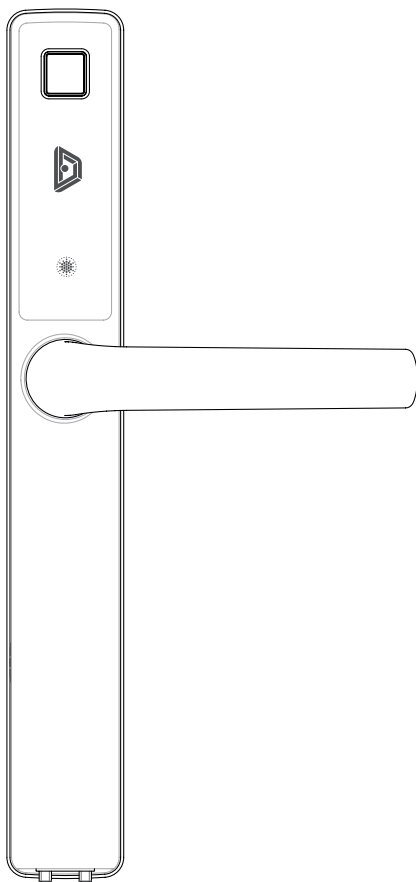

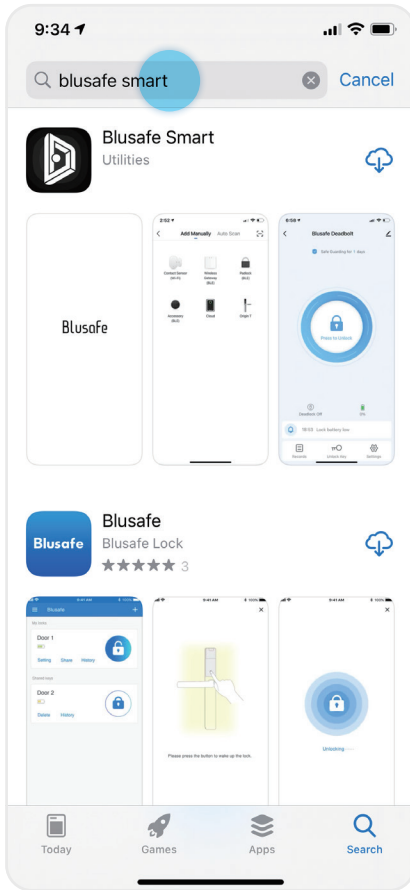


APPLICATION DOWNLOAD AND USER REGISTRATION

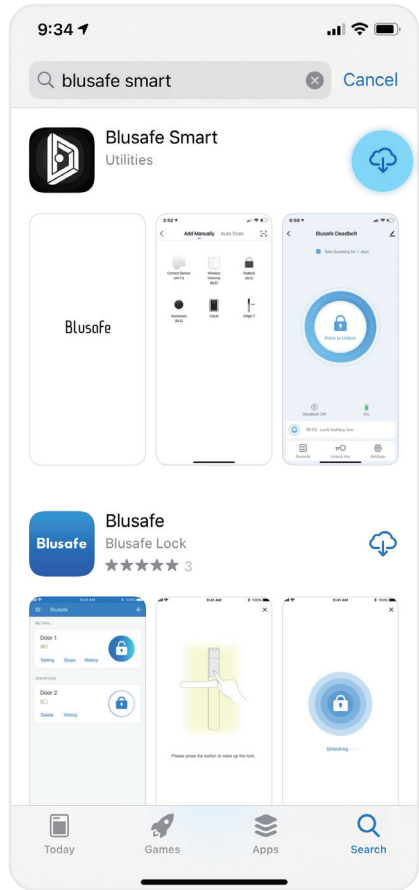
To get the most out of your new Blusafe Smart Lock, you will need to download the "Blusafe Smart" App from either the App Store or Google Play Store depending on the type of smart device you own. After the Application is downloaded, you will need to register your new lock in the Application.

1.1 APPLICATION DOWNLOAD

① In the App Store or Google Play, search "Blusafe Smart".



② Once you have found the "Blusafe Smart" App, click "Download".



Important!



- When searching for the "Blusafe Smart" App, you may also find the "Blusafe" App. Please make sure you download the "Blusafe Smart" App as the normal "Blusafe" App is not compatible with this lock.
- If you have already downloaded the "Blusafe Smart" App and registered an account, you can click "Open" and skip the user registration step.
- Even if you are using Google Home, Amazon Alexa, or another Smart Home Device Manager, you will still need to complete the App Download and User Registration steps.

- If you have already registered an account, you can skip the user registration step and proceed directly to Managing Home Access and Access Levels.

① When you open the Blusafe Smart App, a popup box will appear with the User Agreement and Privacy Policy. Please read and click "Agree".

② Once you click Agree, you will be taken to the Entrance Page. Click "Sign Up".

- The App requires that the password be a mix of both letters and numbers. However, we suggest using a password of at least 8 characters. MANAGING HOME ACCESS AND ACCESS LEVELS

2.1 INTRODUCTION

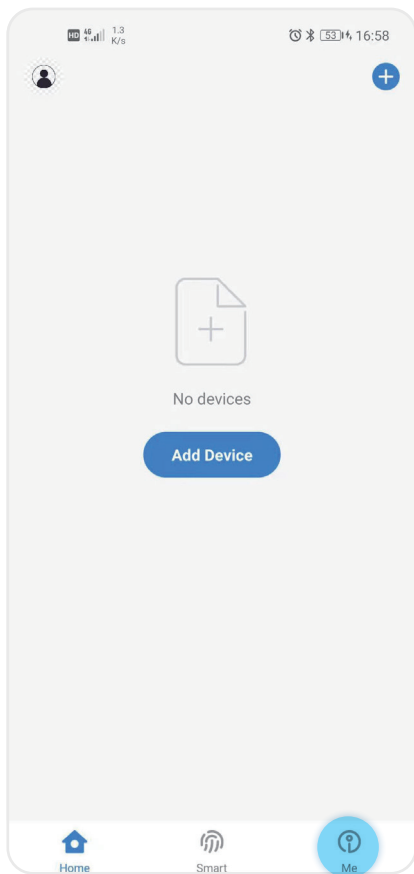
Before adding smart devices into the Blusafe Smart App, a 'Smart Home' must first be created; different levels of access to different home members will be generated.

There are three levels of access for your new smart home. Each access level has different levels of authority for accessing the smart lock and other smart devices, and adding / removing users. The table below provides an explanation of the different access levels.

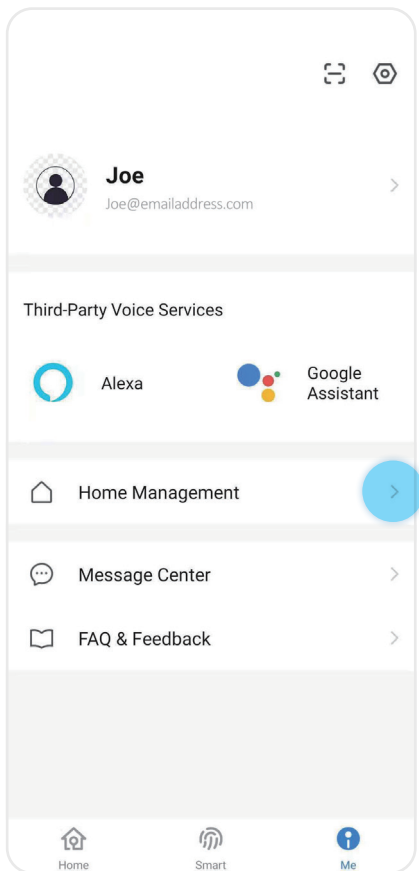
Access Level	# Allowed	Authority	Authority Description	Comments
Homeowner	1	Highest	Control of device setting and operations and can add / edit / delete all administrators and common members.	This is the first account created. Please see below for instructions on how to change the "Homeowner".
Administrator	Unlimited	High	Has control of device settings and operations and can add / edit / delete common members.	Typically, Administrators are other family members or residents who live in the home or unit.
Common Member	Unlimited	Low	Can operate the device and can add / modify / delete their own fingerprint or keycard.	Common Level access is typically granted to individuals who need short-term or limited access, such as a housekeeper, handyman, guest, and so on.

Alternative — Inviting Individual with unregistered email account



The homeowner may invite an individual with an unregistered email account to join the home. To do this, instead of selecting "App Account" in "Add Member" (Step 6 above), select "Copy", and send the copied invitation to an invitee via email or SMS.

- The Invitee will receive the invitation. The invitee should follow the instructions in the email / message to download the Blusafe Smart App and register.
- The Invitee must now select "Join a Home" in the "Home Management" and enter the invitation code.
- Once joined, the invitee will become a "Common Member" automatically. The homeowner can change the invitee's family role under the Home Member in "Home Settings" page.

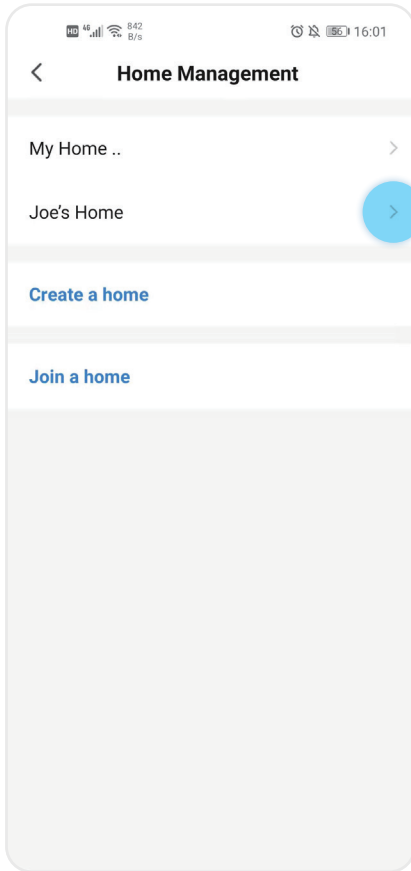
- The removal of a member can only be done by the Homeowner or an Administrator. The exception is that a normal Administrator cannot remove a Homeowner.
- If a fingerprint / key card is added via the 'SET' button and then bound to a member on the App, delete the fingerprint / key card on the App before removing the member. Please refer to instructions for adding fingerprint / key card via the SET button.

PAIRING AND NAMING YOUR LOCK

This section involves adding and pairing your new Blusafe smart lock to the Blusafe Smart Application. It is important to follow the steps carefully. This section must be completed before you can setup and fully use your new smart lock.

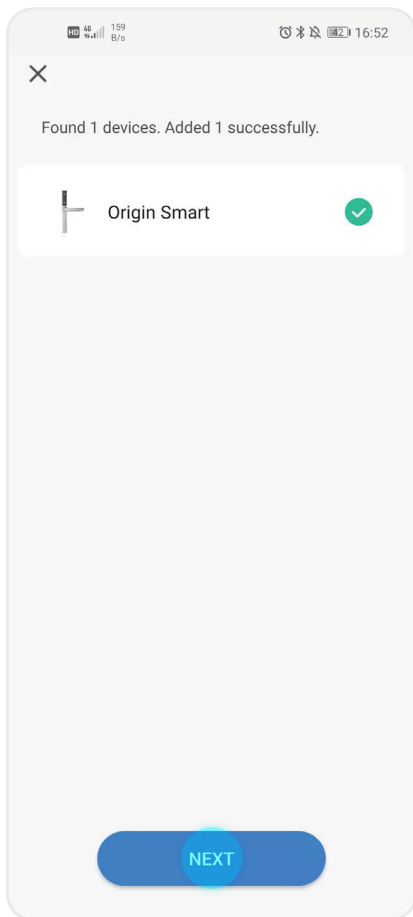
3.1 PAIRING YOUR LOCK WITH THE APP

- ① In the Blusafe Smart App, click "Add Device".
- ② A "Device to be added" window will pop up automatically. Click "Go to add", the lock will begin pairing with the App.

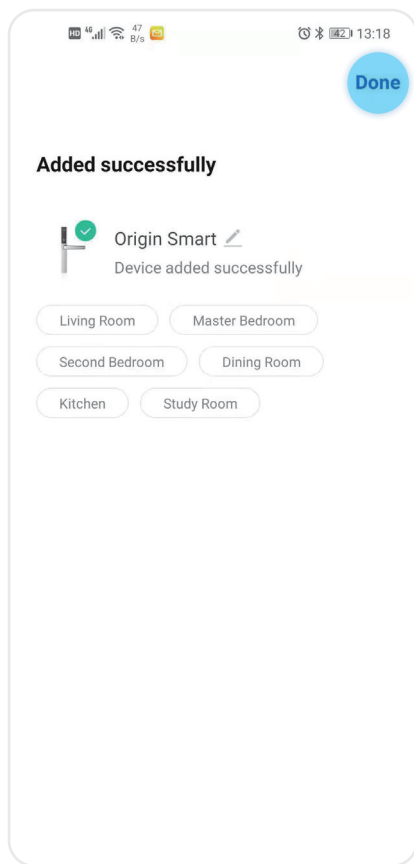

④ A popup will appear "Added successfully". Click "Done".



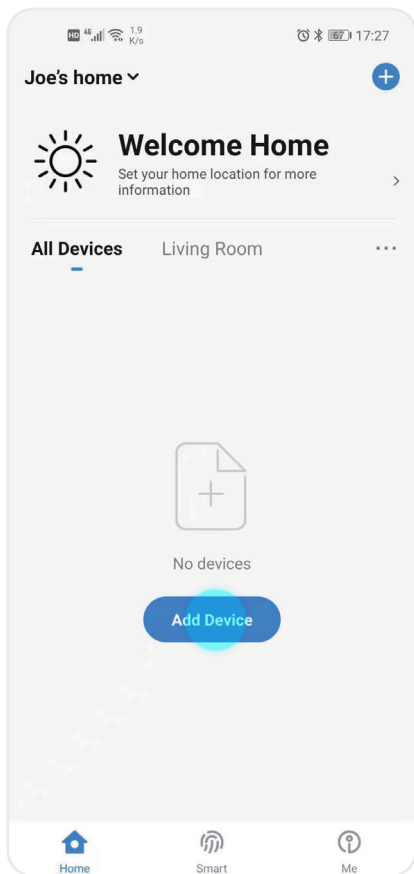

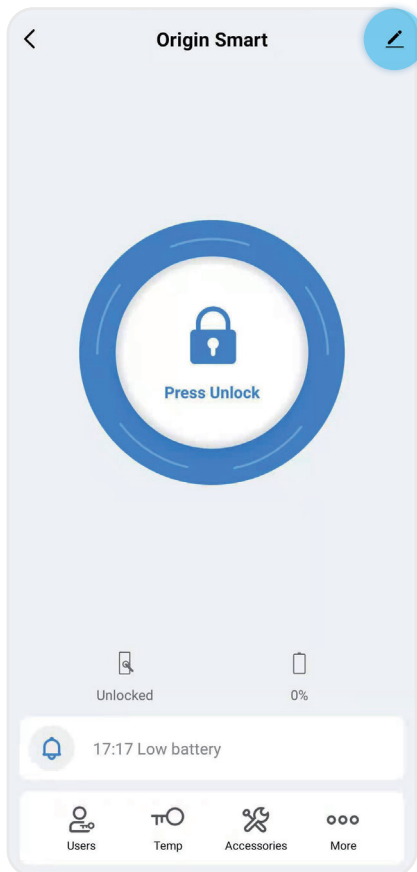
Tip

- The default name of your lock is the model of the lock. You can skip this step if you do not want to change the name of your lock. However, we do suggest you change the name of the lock to correspond to its function, such as "Front Door Lock", to limit any potential confusion with other IoT devices.

① In the application's main page, click the lock icon that represents your new smart lock.

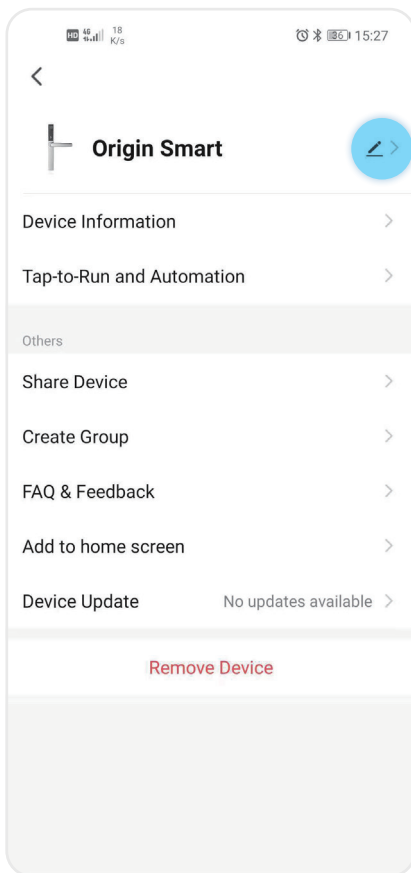


② Now, click the pencil icon at the top right corner of your screen and enter the device information.

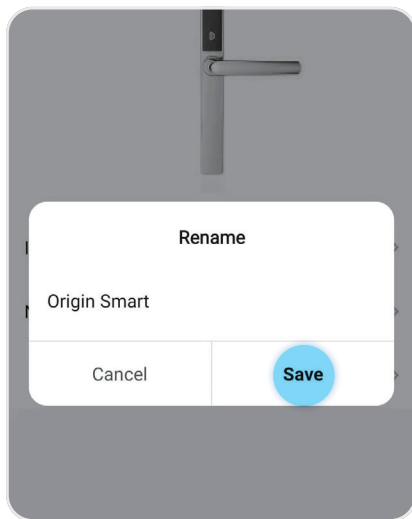
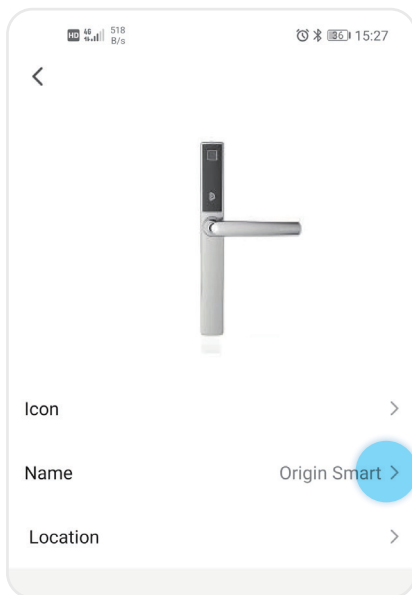

④ Click "Name", to edit the name of your new smart lock.



4 SETTING DOOR HANDLE/LOCK ORIENTATION

Doors have either a right-handed or left-handed orientation. To determine the orientation of your door, stand on the outside of your door. If the door hinge is on your right-hand side, then it is a Right-Hand Orientation door. If the door hinge is on your left-hand side, then it is a Left-Hand Orientation door. The handle is set as Right-Hand by default.

Important!



- Ensure the handle/lock is installed in the correct orientation prior to operating the lock or adding any fingerprints. This will impact the operation of the locking/unlocking mechanism.

1. The first time the lock is powered on or reset to default, you will hear a voice prompt to help you complete Origin Smart handle/lock orientation, which will be either a right-hand orientation, or a left-hand orientation.
2. Once you have set the door orientation, please test the lock by using the door handle to open the lock.

Fix — Handle Not Moving



- If the handle cannot be pushed down, unlock the smart lock using the thumb turn knob on the internal panel of the lock, then push the handle down.

3. After the door handle orientation is complete and you have successfully tested the lock, the lock will enter "Installation Mode" and you will be able to add fingerprints and key cards.

Important!



- The default setting of the lock is "Installation Mode". While in "Installation Mode", any fingerprint or key card can be used to unlock the smart lock. Once a fingerprint or key card has been added, the lock will no longer be in "Installation Mode" and only those fingerprints and cards added will unlock the smart lock.



PAIRING YOUR ORIGIN SMART WITH AN EXTERNAL KEYPAD

If you do not have a Blusafe External Keypad for your Origin Smart, you may skip this step.

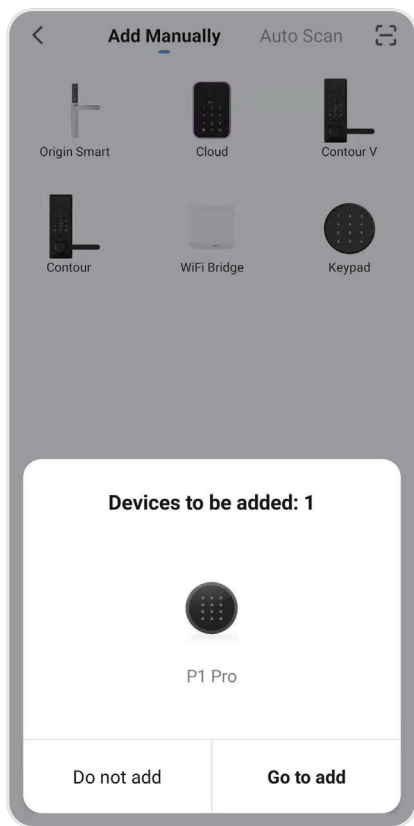
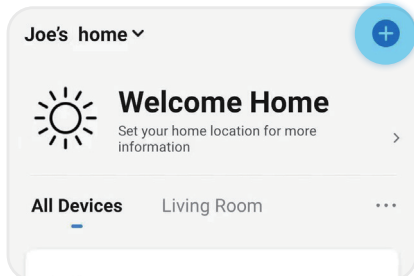
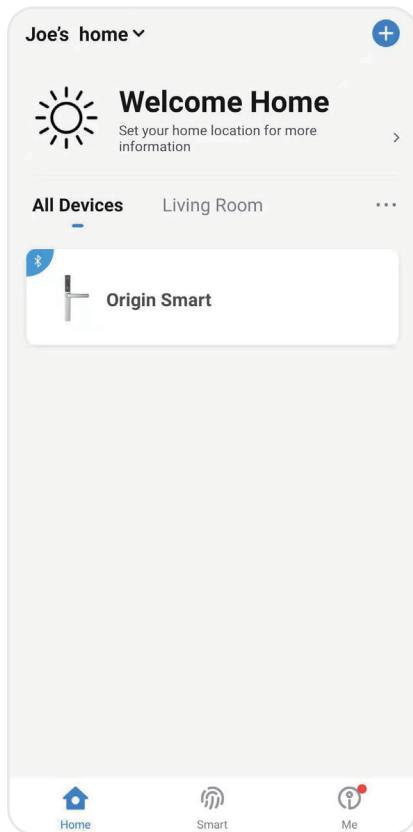
Important!



- It is important to follow the installation instructions for the keypad properly. Failure to do so may result in communication errors between the keypad and the lock.
- The Homeowner account must be setup on a smart device before the Keypad can be paired with the lock.

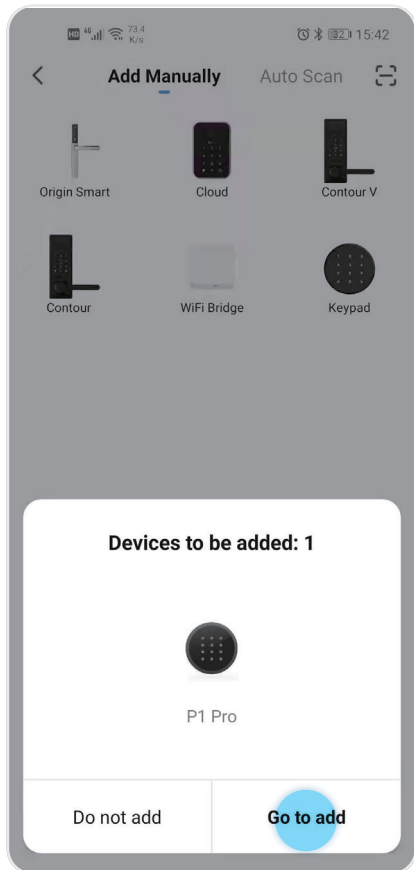

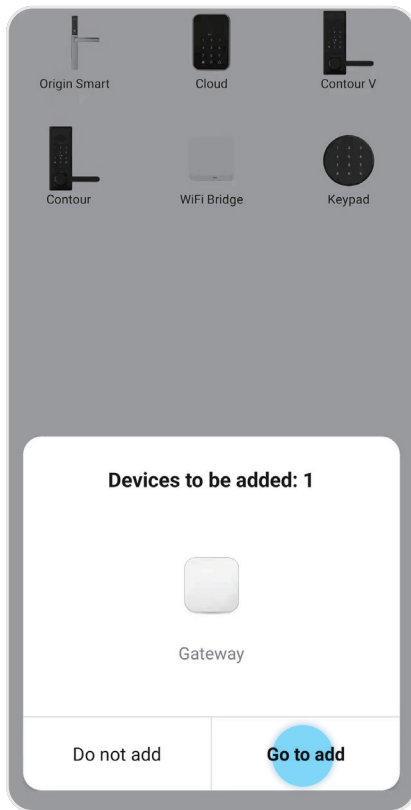


- The Homeowner account must be setup on the smart device being used to pair the Connect Wi-Fi bridge and the lock / keypad.
- The Connect Wi-Fi bridge should be plugged in and be within approximately 1 metre (4 feet) of the lock / keypad during pairing.
- The smart device and the Wi-Fi bridge must be connected to the same Wi-Fi network during the pairing.
- Please make sure any VPN on your smart device is turned OFF during the pairing.

① Enter the Blusafe Smart Application on your smart device.



② When you open the App, a popup window will appear titled "Device to be added". Select "Go to add".



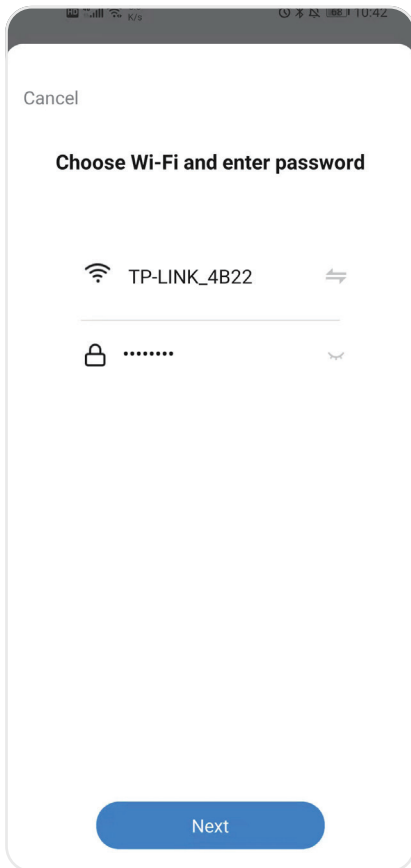

Fix — Popup not Appearing

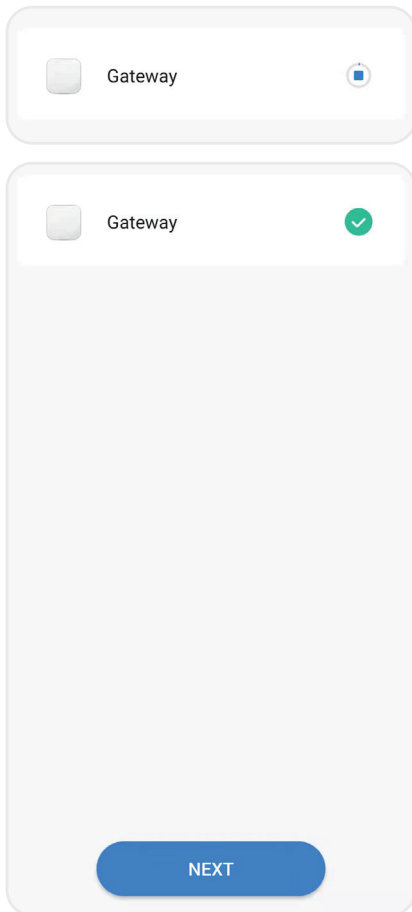


- If the popup window does not appear when you open the App, please close the Application, and unplug the Wi-Fi bridge. Once the App is closed and Wi-Fi is unplugged, plug in the Wi-Fi bridge first and then open the App on your smart device.
- Alternatively, stand close to the bridge, and click "+" at top right corner in the App main page, followed by "Add Manually". You will see a Wi-Fi bridge/gateway icon display. Select the Wi-Fi bridge you want to add.

③ Enter the bridge interface, select Wi-Fi, and enter the Wi-Fi password. Click "Next". After you click "Next", the Wi-Fi bridge will start pairing with the App.

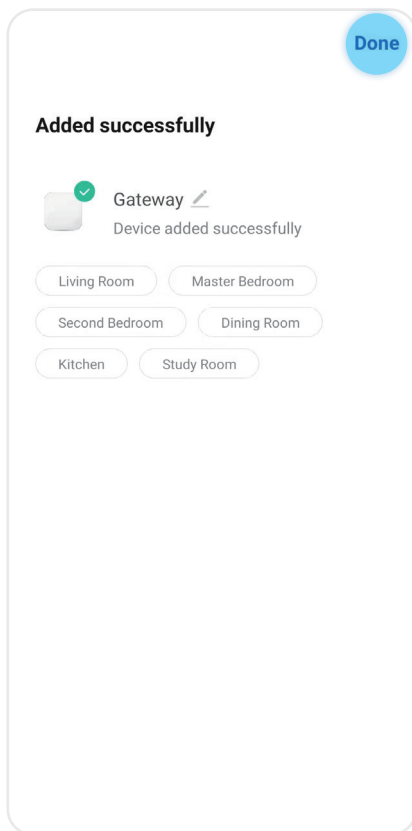

- ⑨ The lock / keypad and the Wi-Fi bridge will start pairing. Once finished, click "add finish". The pairing between the Wi-Fi bridge and lock / keypad is now complete.



Note

- After the pairing is complete, users with Administrator access can now remotely manage and control the lock / keypad. For example, remotely unlock the lock using the App, add e-keys; remotely add / manage / delete passcodes on keypad and so on.



MANAGING LOCKING AND UNLOCKING METHODS

7.1 INTRODUCTION

Your new Origin Smart lock has several means by which it can be unlocked, which include:

- Fingerprint
- Smart Device Application (Bluetooth or Wi-Fi with the Wi-Fi bridge)
- Key Pad (if Blusafe keypad is paired with the lock)
- Key Card
- Manually

There are also several temporary e-keys and codes that can be provided to individuals. Instructions on setting up and operating each locking/unlocking method are in the below sections.

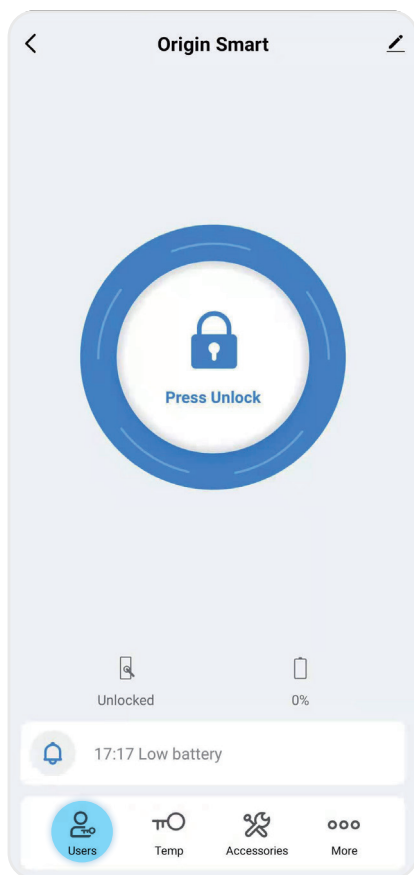
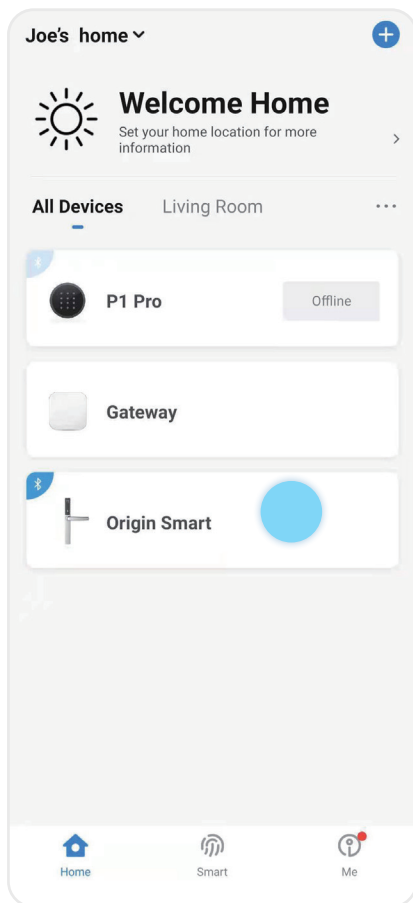
Important!



- The Homeowner or an Administrator can add fingerprints for all members;
- The Common Member can only add own fingerprints.

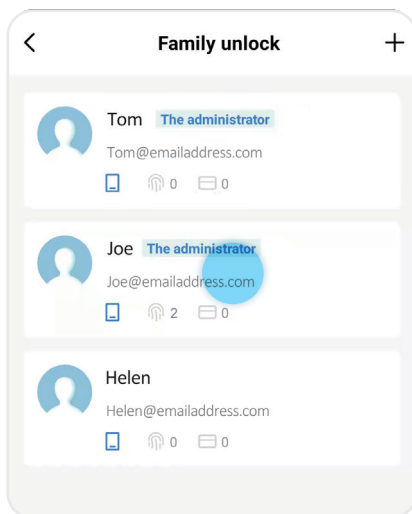
① Enter the Blusafe Smart Application on your smart device, and enter the lock interface.

② Click "Users" at the bottom of the screen.

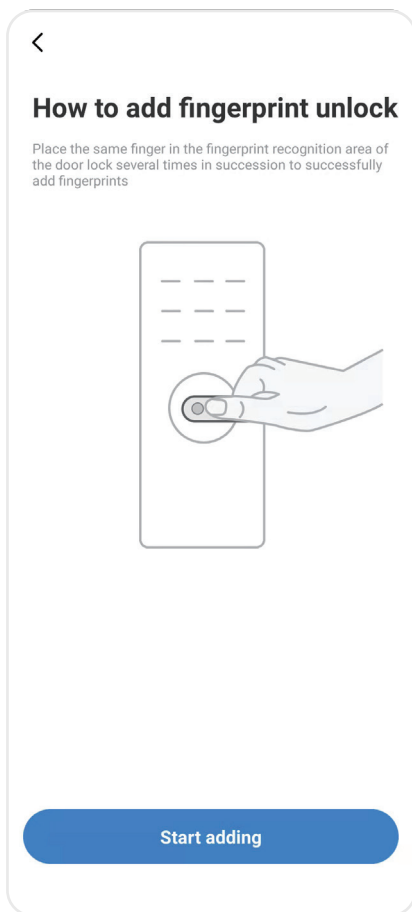

- The fingerprint sensor will need to take several scans of your fingerprint. We suggest that you change the position of your finger during scans when adding a new fingerprint.

- ⑥ After the scans are complete, you can edit the name of the fingerprint, or set it as a "Special Fingerprint" in the App.

- Once set as a "Special Fingerprint", an administrator can choose to receive notifications via the App each time the "Special Fingerprint" is used.

Blusafe Keypad — Code options:

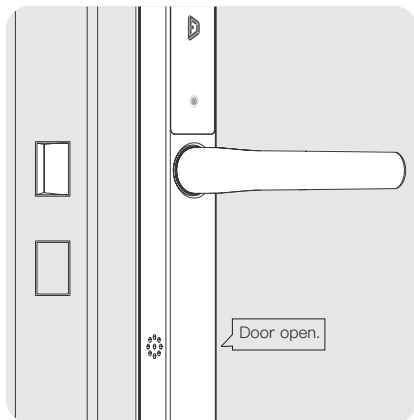
- I. If a fingerprint scan fails to operate the lock, please ensure both the fingerprint sensor and finger that touches the sensor are clean, dry and free from grease, and then try again.
- II. If cleaning the fingerprint sensor and the finger do not work, please try again using a different fingerprint that is registered by the member to operate the lock. You may need to delete and re-add the fingerprint of the finger that failed to operate the lock.
- III. If no fingerprint is working, please use the App, key card or keypad to open the door.
- IV. If no entry method is working, the batteries likely do not have power. Please try using a backup power outlet with a 9V battery, and then your fingerprint, key card, keypad or App to operate the lock.

- If you are unlocking remotely and you cannot connect to the lock, there may be a problem with the Wi-Fi connection at the property.
- Providing the above does not work, try completely closing the App and re-opening it again.

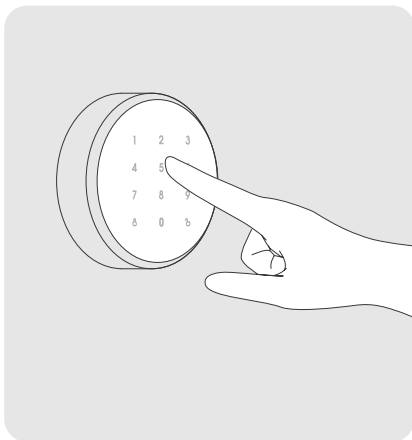

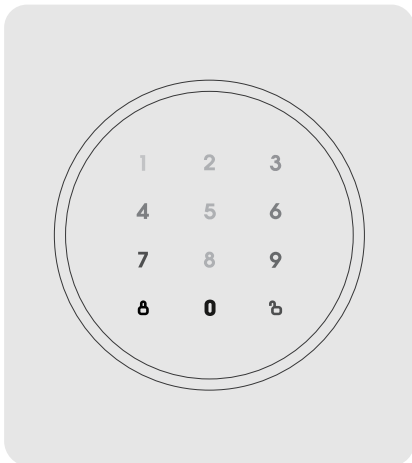


- To wake the keypad up, place your hand over the face of the keypad, the numbers should light up.

- ① To unlock your Origin Smart, enter your 6–10–digit passcode and press the unlock icon.



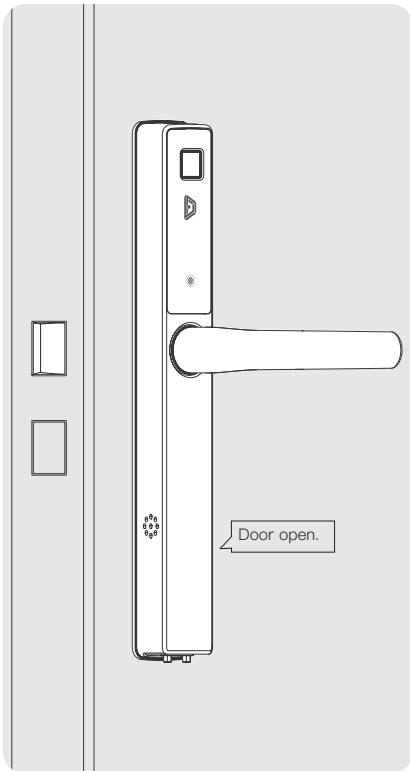

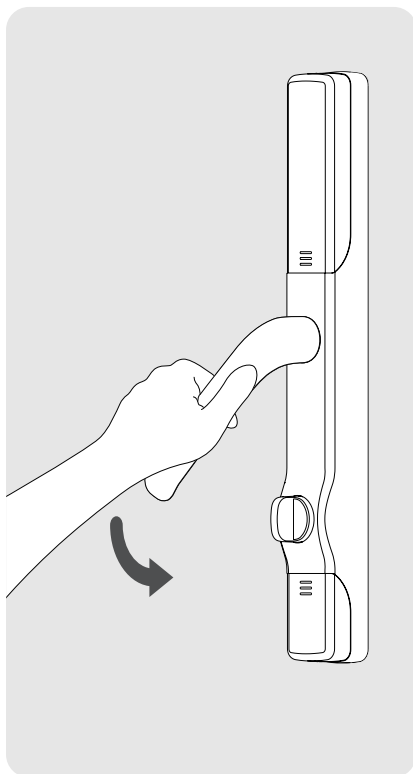
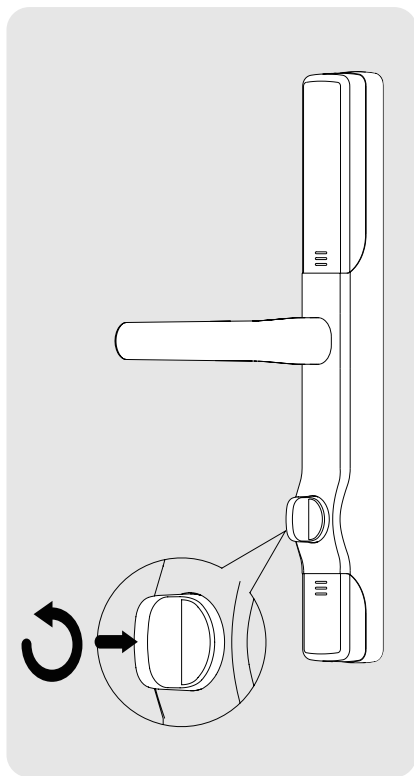
- Please allow up to 20 seconds for the keypad to connect to the handle once you enter the passcode, on some occasions it takes longer to connect.
- ③ Upon successful connection, you will hear 'Door open' and push down the handle to unlock.

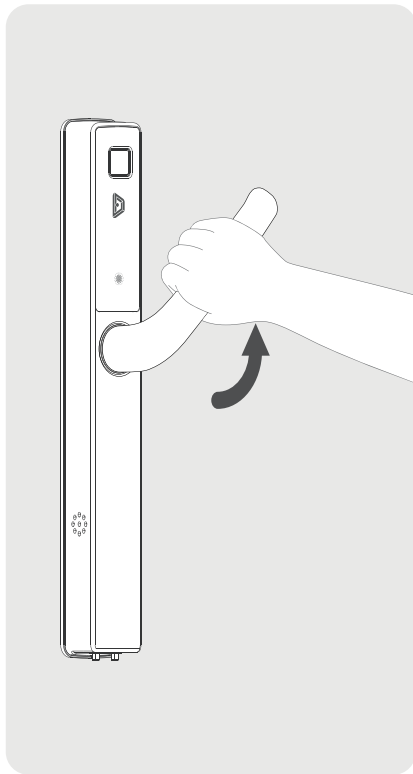

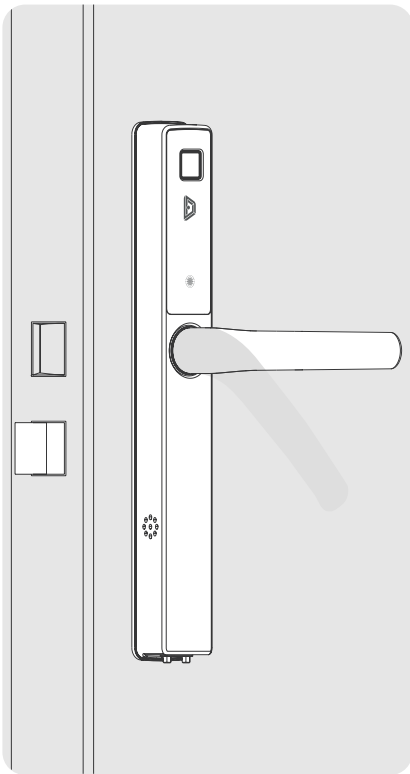
LOCKING THE DOOR – DEAD-LOCK

After entering or exiting, close the door and lift the lever handle, this will automatically lock the door.



LOCKING THE DOOR – AUTO LOCKING

If the lever handle is not depressed 30 seconds after App / Fingerprint / Key Card / Passcode unlock, the lock will re-lock itself automatically.

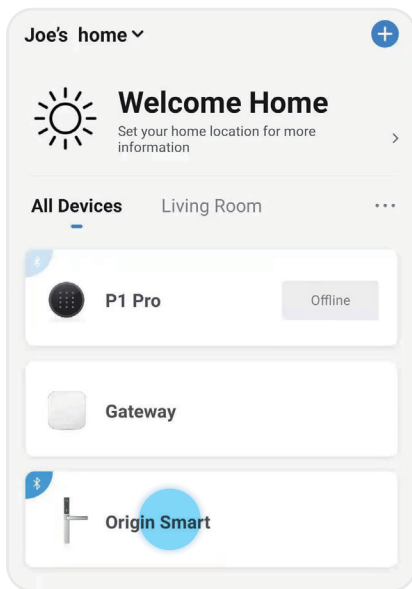
- You should hear a voice prompt 'Door locked' once the handle is lifted.
- You should feel the door locking mechanism and hear the deadbolt extend.
- If you do not hear the above, try lifting the handle again gently.



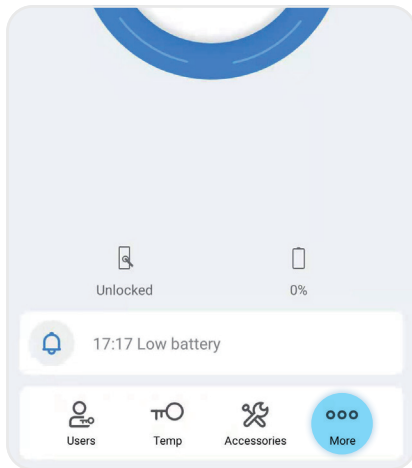

9.2 BACKUP POWER

A 9V alkaline battery can be used to provide backup power to your Origin Smart in case the installed batteries run out of power.

- ① Connect a 9V alkaline battery to the backup power portal located underneath the external handle.
- ② While the 9V alkaline battery is connected, use the fingerprint scanner, App, keypad, or key card to unlock your Origin Smart.

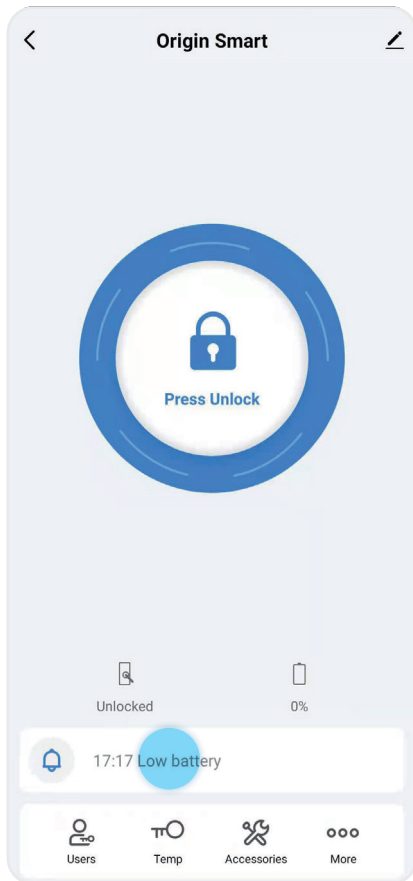
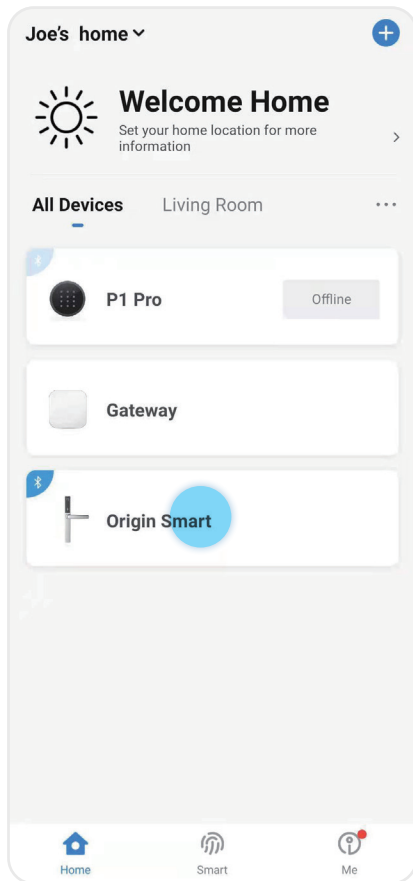


- It is important to replace the internal batteries as soon as possible.
- Please make sure you use the 9V alkaline battery instead of 9V zinc carbon battery!

9.3 SEARCH RECORDS

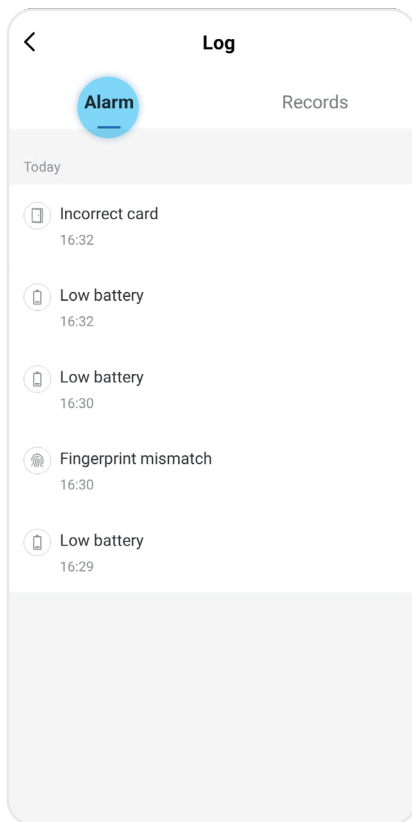
The Homeowner and other members with Administrator level authority can access the unlock records/activity log. This shows a record of every time the door was unlocked, at what times it was unlocked, and by which users. (This is why it is important to name fingerprints, key cards and passcodes).

- ① Enter the Blusafe Smart Application on your smart device. Click on the lock interface.
- ② Click the Bell icon at the bottom of your screen.

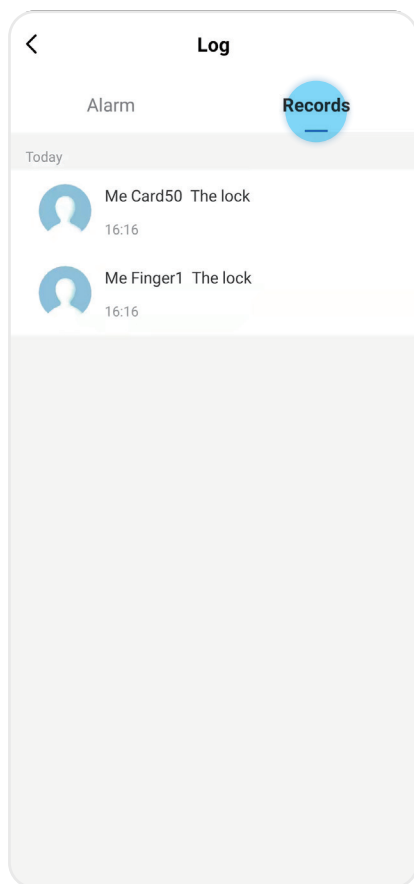

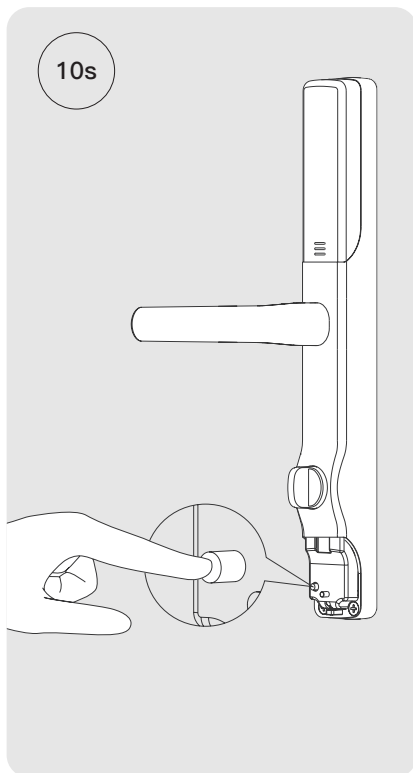
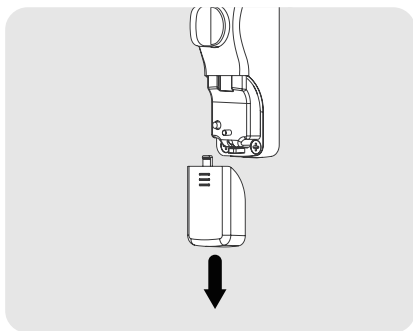
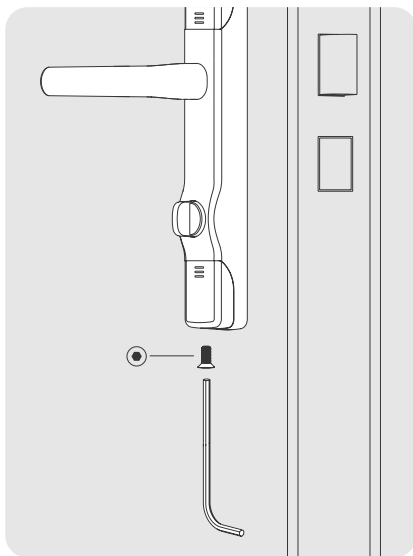
Warning!



- Using the "Set" button instead of the App to clear user data will delete ALL fingerprints and key-cards data stored in the lock.
- After clearing all user data, the existing Homeowner will need to pair with the lock before other members can use the App to control the lock; if a new user pairs with the lock as Homeowner, previous home members will not be able to see or control the lock in the App.
- We recommend that you remove fingerprints and key-cards via the App for more control.

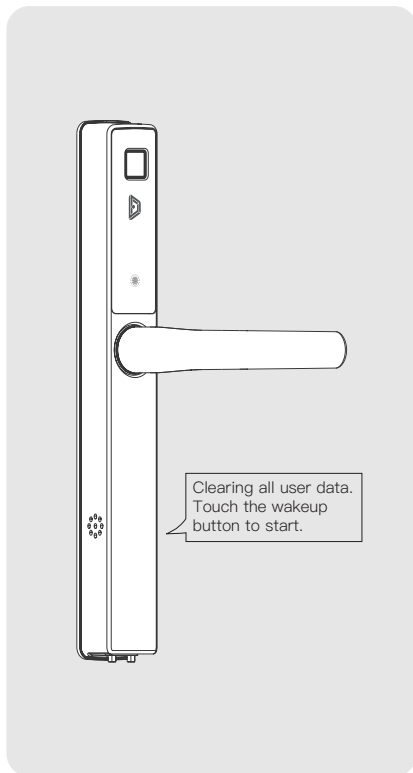

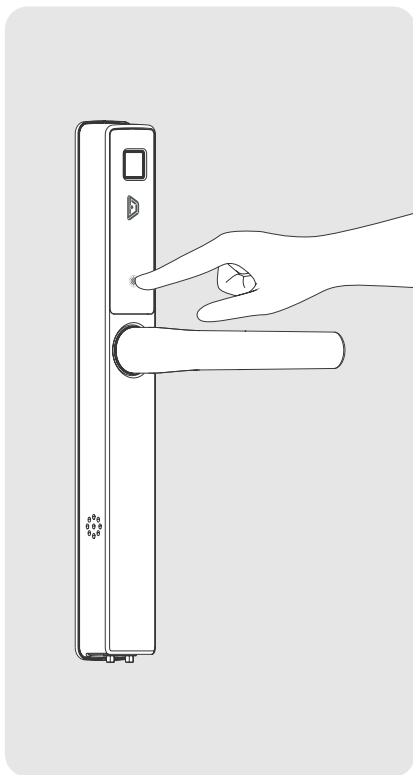

MANAGING SYSTEM LOCKOUT, RECOVERY, FIRMWARE UPGRADE, AND RESET

10.1 SYSTEM LOCKOUT

After 5 consecutive failed unlock attempts using a key card or fingerprint, you will hear "Usage limit exceed. Try again later." and your Origin Smart will enter lockdown mode for 1 minute.

During lockdown mode, the key card and fingerprint scanner will be inoperative; however, your Origin Smart can still be operated by using the App.

After the 1-minute lockdown period is complete, all entry methods will work.

10.2 SYSTEM RECOVERY

A system recovery will be triggered automatically after an unsuccessful firmware upgrade. The lock system will be recovered to a previous workable version of firmware once triggered.

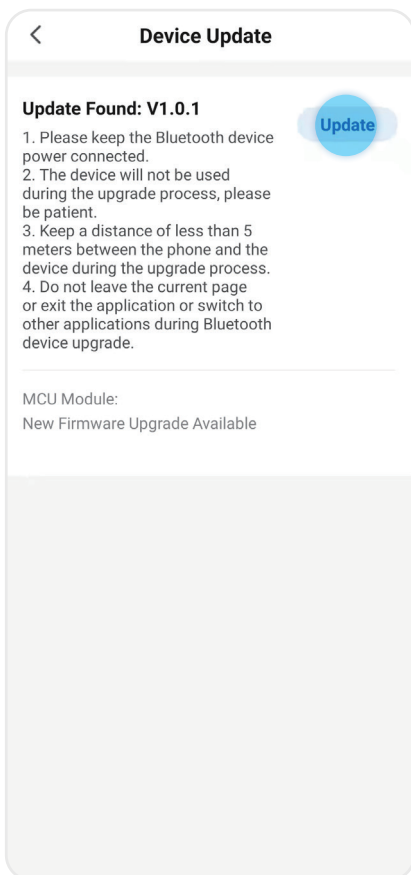
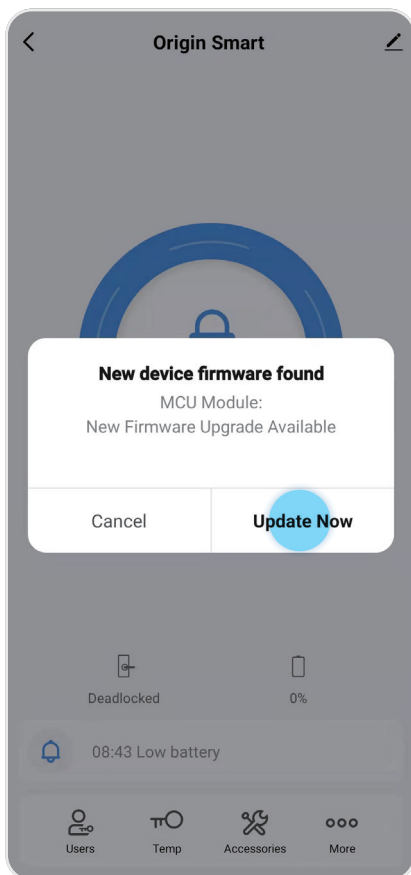

Once a firmware upgrade available, a notification will pop up automatically in device interface of the Blusafe Smart App. Click "Upgrade Now" to complete the process.

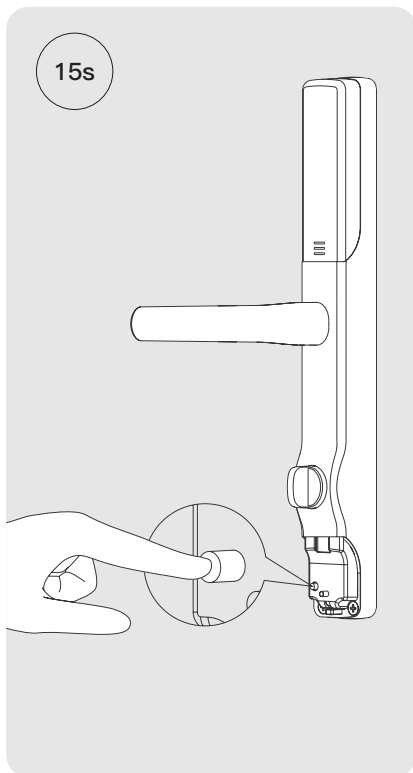
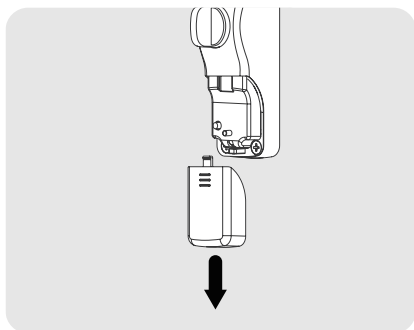
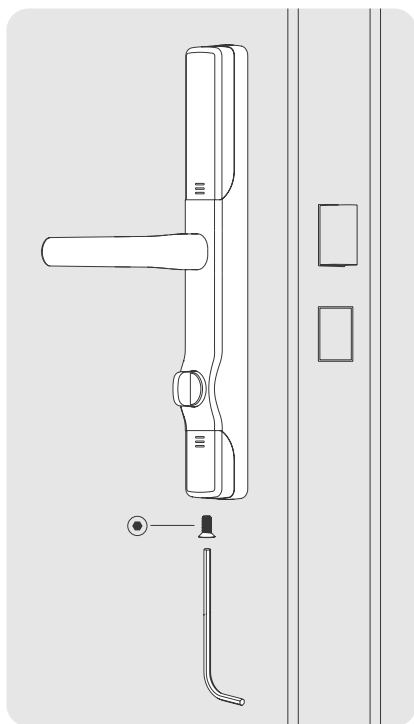
